Cows: April to May - Gradually increase to 2 - 4 lb/head/day; **June to August -** Feed 2 - 6 lb/head/day; **September to October -** Flush for breeding season. Feed 2 lb/head/day along with up to 5 lb/head/day of grain.

Bulls: February to June - Velvet Diet. Feed 3 -8 lb/head/day of product or 3 - 5 lb of product with 1 - 3 lb/head/day of grain; **July to January -** Maintenance Diet. Feed 1 - 2 lb product with 1 - 3 lb grain/head/day, depending on condition.
